### A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$22,000.00 from the funds collected under the Tourism Entertainment and Destination Enhancement Act of 2013 pursuant to 4 CMC § 1511(d); and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

- **Section 1.** Short Title. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$22,000.00 from the funds collected under the Tourism Entertainment and Destination Enhancement Act of 2013 pursuant to 4 CMC § 1511(d) for various programs in the Second Senatorial District.
- **Section 2.** <u>Appropriation.</u> There is hereby appropriated \$22,000.00 from the funds collected under the Tourism Entertainment and Destination Enhancement Act of 2013 pursuant to 4 CMC § 1511(d), to be expended as follows:

#### "Tourism Enhancement Beach Beautification Project \$22,000.00"

- **Section 3.** Expenditure Authority. For the funds appropriated under Section 2(a) of this Act, the Mayor of Tinian shall be the expenditure authority.
- **Section 4.** <u>Management of Funds</u>. Funds appropriated under this Act shall be transferred to an account to be set up by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer. The Tinian Municipal Treasurer shall regulate and control the funds appropriated under this Act so that no funds may be expended contrary to this Act or fiscal management policies of the Municipality of Tinian and Aguiguan or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands."

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**Section 5.** <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

**Section 7.** Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
