A LOCAL ACT  
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT (TINIAN)

To address a local matter in the Office of the Mayor, that is, the Mayor's timely submission of Resident Department Heads to the Municipal Council for confirmation, repealing any inconsistent Municipal Ordinances, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT OF TINIAN  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE

1           Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this local Act is to better  
2 organize the Office of the local mayor by requiring that the Mayor's  
3 Appointment of Resident Department Heads be submitted to the Municipal  
4 Council in a timely fashion for confirmation.

5           Section 2. Mayor's Appointment of Resident Department Heads -  
6 Timely Submission to Municipal Council for Confirmation Required. The  
7 Mayor's Appointment of Resident Department Heads, pursuant to Section 3  
8 (g) of Amendment No. 25 to the Commonwealth Constitution, shall be  
9 submitted to the Municipal Council within five (5) days following the  
10 date the person was temporarily appointed.


11           Section 3. Appointments: Failure to Confirm. If the Mayor's  
12 appointment pursuant to Section 2 of this Act is not confirmed by the  
13 Municipal Council within thirty (30) days from the date the person was  
14 temporarily appointed, the appointment shall automatically terminate and  
15 the position shall become vacant and the person nominated shall not be  
16 renominated.


17           Section 4. Repealer. Any Tinian Municipal Ordinance that is  
18 inconsistent with the provision of this Act is hereby repealed.


1 Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the  
2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the  
3 invalidity does not effect other provisions or applications of the Act  
4 which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application  
5 and to this end the provisions of the Act are severable.

6 Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its  
7 approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
