TINIAN LOCAL LAW NO. 16-1
House Local Bill No. 16-04

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$98,000.00 from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial District to fund the Tinian Municipal Scholarship Program; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 11, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **Section 1. Purpose.** The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$98,000.00 from the
2 local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines to fund the Tinian Municipal
3 Scholarship Program administered by the Tinian Municipal Scholarship Board in the Second
4 Senatorial District.

5 **Section 2. Appropriation.** The sum of \$98,000.00 is hereby appropriated from
6 revenues collected pursuant to Tinian Local Law 14-2, to be expended for the scholarships
7 awarded by the Tinian Municipal Scholarship Board.

8 **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** The Tinian Municipal Scholarship Board shall be
9 the expenditure authority of funds appropriated under this Act.


10 **Section 4. Reprogramming.** Funds appropriated under this Act shall be available
11 without fiscal year limitation and shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

12 **Section 5. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or the application of any such
13 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
14 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
15 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


1 **Section 6. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
2 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
3 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained
4 in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The
5 enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any
6 liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes
7 effective.

8 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
9 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.


