TINIAN LOCAL LAW NO. 16-2  
HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 16-8

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate \$25,000.00 from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial District for the transition of students from the NMC Tinian campus to the NMC Saipan campus; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH  
CODE:**

2           **Section 1. Purpose.** The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$25,000.00 from the  
3 local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines for the transition of students  
4 from the NMC campus located in the Second Senatorial District to the NMC Campus in  
5 Saipan.

6           **Section 2. Appropriation.** The sum of \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated from  
7 revenues collected pursuant to Tinian Local Law 14-2, to defray costs incurred as a result of  
8 the transition of students from the Northern Marianas College Tinian Campus to the Northern  
9 Marianas College Campus in Saipan and for other purposes.

10           **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** The expenditure authority for the funds  
11 appropriated under this Act shall be the President of the Northern Marianas College.

12           **Section 4. Availability.** Funds appropriated under this Act shall be available without  
13 fiscal year limitation.


14           **Section 6. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be  
15 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained


in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or becoming law without such approval.
