Tinian Local Law No. 16-4
HOUSE BILL NO. 16-17

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$16,000.00 from the local license fees collected for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial District for the transition of students from the NMC Tinian campus to the Saipan NMC campus and for the purchase of computer equipment for the Department of Labor on Tinian; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE
COMMONWEALTH CODE:

- 1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$9,000.00 collected from
2 the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines for the transition of students from
3 the NMC campus located in the Second Senatorial District to the NMC campus on Saipan.
- 4 Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of \$16,000.00 is hereby appropriated from revenues
5 collected pursuant to Tinian Local Law 14-2 as follows:
- 6 (a) \$9,000.00 to defray costs incurred for housing and transportation as a result of the
7 transfer of students from the Northern Marianas College Campus on Tinian to the
8 Northern Marianas College Campus on Saipan.
- 9 (b) \$7,000.00 for the purchase of computer equipment for the Department of Labor,
10 Tinian.
- 11 Section 3. Expenditure Authority. The expenditure authority for the funds appropriated under
12 Section 2(a) of this Act shall be the President of the Northern Marianas College. The expenditure
13 authority for the funds appropriated under Section 2(b) of this Act shall be the Resident Director of the
14 Department of Labor Tinian.


1 Section 4. Availability. Funds appropriated under this Act shall be available without fiscal year
2 limitation.

3 Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to
4 any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder
5 of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is
6 held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


7 Section 6. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed
8 as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any
9 rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any
10 proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect
11 of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
12 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

13 Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or
14 becoming law without such approval.


