Tinian Local Law No. 16-5  
HOUSE BILL NO. 16-21

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A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$11,000.00 from the Developer Infrastructure Tax  
collected in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE  
COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1           Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The Tinian Legislative Delegation finds that there  
2 is a balance of \$11,000.00 in unobligated funds from the Developer Infrastructure Tax  
3 collected in the Second Senatorial District and is available for appropriation. Therefore, the  
4 purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$11,000.00 collected from the Developer Infrastructure  
5 Tax in the Second Senatorial District for the completion of the Tinian Fire Station Roll-up  
6 Doors/Exhaust Vents Project.

7           Section 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated \$11,000.00 collected from  
8 the Developer Infrastructure Tax collected in the Second Senatorial District for the completion  
9 of the Tinian Fire Station Roll-up Doors/Exhaust Vents Project.

10          Section 3. Expenditure Authority. Expenditure authority for the funds appropriated  
11 under this Act shall be the Resident Director of the Tinian Department of Public Safety.


12          Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such  
13 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent  
14 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or  
15 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


16          Section 6. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be  
17 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes

1 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained  
2 in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The  
3 enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any  
4 liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes  
5 effective.


6 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the  
7 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.
