HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 16-25

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$42,000.00 from the local license fees collected from pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE
COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$42,000.00 collected from the
2 local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines for subsistence allowances for
3 dialysis and cancer patients from the Second Senatorial District and for the operation of the Tinian
4 Legislative Delegation under the Senate Leadership.

5 Section 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated \$42,000.00 from the local license fees
6 for pachinko slot machines and poker machines, pursuant to Tinian Local Law 14-2, to be expended as
7 follows:

- 8 (a) Monthly subsistence allowance for dialysis, cancer,
9 multiple sclerosis, post cervical, and vascular accident
10 patients from Tinian \$12,000.00
11 (b) For the operation of the Tinian Legislative Delegation
12 under the Senate Leadership \$30,000.00

13 Section 3. Expenditure Authority. For the funds appropriated under Section 2(a) of this Act,
14 the Secretary of Finance shall prepare and disburse the amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 each month for
15 a period of six months until the entire appropriated amount of \$12,000 is expended. The allocated
16 amount of \$2,000.00 shall be distributed equally among all eligible dialysis, cancer, multiple sclerosis


1 and post cervical, vascular accidents from Tinian each month. For the funds appropriated under Section
2 2(b) the expenditure authority shall be the Senate President with the concurrence of the members of the
3 Tinian Legislative Delegation.

4 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to
5 any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder
6 of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is
7 held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

8 Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed
9 as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any
10 rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any
11 proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect
12 of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
13 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

14 Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or
15 becoming law without such approval.


