Tinian Local Law 16-9

HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 16-31, D1

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate \$18,800.00 from the local license fees collected for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1
OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **Section 1. Purpose.** The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$18,800.00 collected
2 from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines for the payment of
3 tuition of the Tinian students attending the nursing program of Emmanuel Educational
4 Services, Inc., and for the purchase of an air conditioning unit for the Tinian Aging Center.

5 **Section 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$18,800.00 from
6 the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines collected pursuant to
7 Tinian Local Law 14-2, to be expended as follows:

- 8 a. Tinian Mayor for the payment of the outstanding
9 tuition of the Tinian students attending the nursing
10 program of Emmanuel Educational Services, Inc. \$15,000.00
- 11 b. Tinian Department of Community and Cultural Affairs
12 for the purchase of an air-conditioning unit for the Tinian
13 Aging Center \$ 3,800.00

14 **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** The expenditure authority for the funds
15 appropriated under Section 2(a) of this Act shall be the Mayor of Tinian. The expenditure


1 authority for the funds appropriated under Section 2(b) of this Act shall be the Resident
2 Director of the Tinian Department of Community and Cultural Affairs.

3 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act, or the application of any such
4 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
5 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
6 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


7 **Section 5. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
8 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
9 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained
10 in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The
11 enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any
12 liability civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes
13 effective.

14 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
15 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.


