Tinian Local Law 16-10
HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 16-33

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate the sum of \$54,000.00 from Tinian Local Law 15-9; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1
OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **Section 1. Purpose.** The Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation finds that
2 pursuant to Tinian Local Law 15-9, the sum of \$54,000.00 was appropriated from the local
3 license fees collected for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial
4 District for professional services for the relocation of Tinian's landfill. The Tinian and
5 Aguiguan Legislative Delegation further finds that although these funds were appropriated, the
6 professional services contract was not executed and the funds remain available. The Tinian
7 and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation therefore finds it necessary to re-appropriate these funds
8 for the benefit of the Tinian Municipal Scholarship Program.

9 **Section 2. Re-appropriation.** The sum of \$54,000.00 is hereby re-appropriated from
10 Tinian Local Law 15-9 to the Tinian Municipal Scholarship Program.

11 **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** The expenditure authority for the funds
12 appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be the Tinian Municipal Scholarship Board.


13 **Section 4. Availability.** Funds appropriated under this Act shall be available without
14 fiscal year limitation.

1 **Section 5. Severability.** If any provision of this Act, or the application of any such
2 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
3 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
4 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


5 **Section 6. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
6 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
7 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained
8 in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The
9 enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any
10 liability civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes
11 effective.

12 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
13 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.


