Tinian Local Law 16-11  
**HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 16-43**

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate \$110,000.00 from the Developer Infrastructure Tax collected in the Second: Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE  
COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1           **Section 1. Finding and Purpose.** The Tinian Legislative Delegation finds that there is  
2 a balance of \$110,000.00 in unobligated funds from the Developer Infrastructure Tax collected  
3 in the Second Senatorial District and is available for appropriation. Therefore, the purpose of  
4 this Act is to appropriate \$110,000.00 collected from the Developer Infrastructure Tax in the  
5 Second Senatorial District for infrastructure development and improvement projects on the  
6 island of Tinian.

7           **Section 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$110,000.00 from  
8 the Developer Infrastructure Tax collected in the Second Senatorial District to the Office of the  
9 Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan for infrastructure development including road development,  
10 street lighting, electrical distribution, water and sewer development.

11           **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** Expenditure authority for the funds appropriated  
12 under this Act shall be the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan.


13           **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or the application of any such  
14 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent


1 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or  
2 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

3 **Section 5. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be  
4 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
5 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained  
6 in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The  
7 enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any  
8 liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes  
9 effective.


10 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the  
11 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.
