Tinian Local Law 16-12
HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 16-42, SI

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$41,500.00 from the local license fees collected for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DNISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE
COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$41,500.00 collected from the
2 local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines for various programs on the
3 Municipality of Tinian and Aguiguan.

4 Section 2. Appropriation and Expenditure Authority. There is hereby appropriated the sum
5 of \$41,500.00 from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines collected
6 pursuant to Tinian Local Law 14-2 for the following:

12 Section 3. Expenditure Authority. The expenditure authority for the funds appropriated
13 under Section 2(a) of this Act shall be the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan. For the funds appropriated
14 under Section 2(b) of this Act, the Secretary of Finance shall prepare and disburse the amount not to
15 exceed \$2,000.00 each month for a period of five months until the entire appropriated amount of
16 \$10,000 is expended. The allocated amount of \$2,000.00 shall be distributed equally among all eligible



1 dialysis, cancer, multiple sclerosis and post cervical, vascular accidents from Tinian each month. For
2 the funds appropriated under Section 2(c) of this Act, the Secretary of Finance shall disburse a check
3 payable to the Tinian Athletic Sports Association which shall be under the expenditure authority of the
4 Tinian Athletic Sports Association President.

5 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act, or the application of any such provision
6 to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder
7 of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is
8 held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


9 Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed
10 as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any
11 rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any
12 proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect
13 of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability civil or criminal, which shall already be in
14 existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

15 Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or
16 becoming law without such approval.
