

SECOND REGULAR SESSION, 1986

AN ACT

To set up a task force to prepare position papers for the Governor and Legislature on the termination of the Trusteeship.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIFTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 101. Short Title. This Act may be cited as the Termination
2 of Trusteeship Task Force Act.


3 Section 102. Purpose. This Act establishes a Task Force to
4 facilitate termination of the Trusteeship and to advise the Legislature
5 and Governor on all matters relating to smooth and orderly termination of
6 the Trusteeship.

7 Section 103. Task Force. The Task Force on the Termination of the
8 Trusteeship shall have five members. Three members will be appointed by
9 the Governor, one by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one
10 by the President of the Senate.


11 Section 104. Duties. The Task Force shall submit a written report
12 to the Governor and the Legislature within 45 days after their
13 appointment. The Task Force will make further reports as requested by the
14 Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives or the President of
15 the Senate.

16 Section 105. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its
17 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.


