

THIRD SPECIAL SESSION, 1987

AN ACT

To amend Section 3 A., 8., 3B. 1 and 3C, of Public Law 5-17; to amend provisions of Public Law 5-31 to re-allocate the sum of \$1,000,000 for Saipan power plant engine overhaul; and to re-allocate and appropriate other funds to Tinian; and, for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIFTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 3 A., 8., of Public Law 5-17 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"8. Distribution and Extension of Power . . . . . \$625,000

To continue the outreach programs to outlying areas, for power generation equipment, and to upgrade main distribution lines."

Section 2. Amendment. Section 3B. 1. of Public Law 5-17 is hereby amended to supplement the funds appropriated therein by appropriating the sum of \$100,000, the additional revenues are identified in Section 4 of this Act, making the total funds available for Construction of Rota High School Classrooms Phase II \$375,000.

Section 3. Amendment. Section 3C of Public Law 5-17 is hereby amended by adding Section 10 to read as follows:

"10. Power Plant Overhaul . . . . . \$ 65,000

Overhaul of power generators, including parts and labor. Expenditure authority for these funds shall be the Resident Department Head for the Department of Public Works in consultation with the Mayor, and the Commonwealth Utilities Corporation."

Section 4. Amendment. Section 202 of Public Law 5-31 is amended by re-allocating the sum of \$1,200,000 from the sub-total Executive Branch Personnel sum of \$35,080,700 and re-allocating the \$1,000,000 as described in Section 5 of this Act, re-allocating \$100,000 as described in Section 2 of this Act, and re-allocating \$100,000 as described in Sections 3 and 6 of this Act. The 1,200,000 is now available from the governments contribution to social security in that no contributions have been made since January 1987.

Section 5. Re-Allocation. The sum of \$1,000,000 is hereby re-allocated to meet future expenses for the overhaul of four power generating engines located in Saipan's main station. Revenues appropriated in this Section shall not be available for reprogramming. The Governor or his designee may expend funds identified in this Section, and these funds shall remain available until expended for the purpose stated herein.

Section 6. Re-Allocation. The sum of \$35,000 is hereby re-allocated and appropriated as follows:

- b. \$15,000 to Tinian Public Works for equipment and parts purchases. Expenditure authority of these funds shall be the Resident Department Head in consultation with the Mayor.
- c. \$20,000 to Tinian Natural Resources for equipment and parts purchases. Expenditure authority of these funds be the Resident Department Head in consultation with the Mayor.


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
Section 7. Amendment. Section 202(w) is hereby amended by adding the Commonwealth Utilities Corporation (CUC) thereto and re-allocating the sum of \$1 from Public Works Personnel to CUC Personnel. This amendment will now enable the Governor, to at his discretion, reprogram funds from Public Works to CUC in Fiscal Year 1987 so that CUC may begin to assume from Public Works that they are responsible for as in accordance to Public Law 4-47.


Section 8. Amendment. Section 202(t), page 13, line 22 of Public Law 5-31 is amended by changing the word "new" to "used".

Section 9. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
