

AN ACT

To amend Public Law 5-4, Public Law 5-31, Public Law 5-38, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIFTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Public Law 5-4, Section 2(a) and (b) are
2 amended to read as follows:

3 (a) There is hereby established in the Commonwealth
4 Government an Agriculture and Marine Revolving Fund of
5 \$25,000. Such funds were initially appropriated by Section
6 201(1), Subsection 7, Item 1 of Public Law 3-94, shall be
7 expended by the Director of the Department of Natural
8 Resources or his designee and shall be utilized to purchase
9 and sell agricultural equipment, seeds, fertilizers,
10 insecticides, agricultural produce, local catch fish,
11 fishing equipment and accessories, and for other retail
12 purposes.

13 (b) The Director of the Department of Natural
14 Resources shall promulgate rules and regulations as he
15 deems necessary for the expenditure of such funds."

16 Section 2. Amendment. Public Law 5-31 is amended as follows:

17 (a) Section 202(t), Office of the Mayors, reduce the
18 Tinian Mayor's Office FTE from 34 to 22, reduce the sums
19 appropriate for personnel and the total sum appropriated by
20 \$37,590.25.

1 (b) Section 202(1) , Natural Resources (Tinian),
2 increase Plant Industry FTE from 26 to 35, Fish & Wildlife
3 FTE from 4 to 5, and increase the sums appropriated for
4 personnel and the total sum appropriated by \$31,859.15.

5 (c) Section 202(q), Public Works, increase the Tinian
6 Opr./Maint. FTE from 15 to 16, increase the sums appropriated
7 for personnel and the total sum appropriated by \$3,561.95.

8 (d) Section 202(r), Personnel Office, increase the
9 Tinian Operations, FTE fran 4 to 5, increase the sums
10 appropriated for personnel and total sum appropriated by
11 \$2,169,15.

12 (e) Section 401(1), is amended by adding a new
13 sentence to read as follows:

14 "Provided, however, funds appropriated to
15 Municipal Council in Section 202(u) may be used
16 for personnel ."

17 (f) Section 415, is amended by adding a new sentence
18 at the end of the existing sentence, to read as follows:

19 "Employees for the Island of Tinian shall be
20 hired by the Executive Department Head on Saipan
21 for their respective departments."


22 (g) Section 416, line 25, is amended by adding the
23 word "not" between the words "were" and "incurred".

24 Section 3. Amendment. Public Lav 5-38, page 4, line, 1, change
25 "(3)" to "(4)".


1 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act is held
2 invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act
3 shall not be affected thereby.

4 Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its
5 approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.



