

AN ACT

To make supplemental appropriation for the operations and activities of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Short Title. This Act may be cited as the
2 "Second Supplemental Budget Authority Act of 1990."

3 Section 2. Findings and Purpose. The Legislature finds
4 that the Governor of the Commonwealth has identified an
5 additional \$338,572.50 in local revenues in the Nonresident
6 Worker Fee Fund over the funds reflected in House Concurrent
7 Resolutions 7-1 and 7-5. The Legislature further finds that
8 this sum has been approved by the Legislature as available
9 for appropriation in Fiscal Year 1990 by House Concurrent
10 Resolution 7-7. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
11 these funds for the operations and activities of the
12 Commonwealth Government as specified herein.

13 Section 3. Appropriation. The sum of \$128,572.50 is
14 hereby appropriated to the Northern Marianas College for
15 instructional materials, supplies and equipment for the
16 vocational program, and \$50,000.00 is appropriated to the
17 Northern Marianas College for the renovation of vocational
18 facilities at the Marianas High School. Expenditure
19 authority shall rest with the Board of Regents or its
20 designee. The Regents' expenditure authority of the
21 \$50,000.00 for renovation of vocational facilities shall be


1 exercised in consultation with the Public School System.
2 Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L. 5-32, Section 7(b),
3 the sum of \$160,000.00 is hereby appropriated to the Public
4 School System for the purchase of four (4) special vehicles
5 for the transportation of handicapped persons, two (2)
6 vehicles for Saipan, one (1) vehicle for Rota and one (1)
7 vehicle for Tinian. Expenditure authority shall rest with
8 the Commissioner of Education. The funds shall not be
9 reprogrammed or spent for any purpose other than those for
10 which they are appropriated, shall remain available until
11 fully expended without fiscal year limitation, and shall not
12 be subject to continuing resolution.

13 Section 4. Severability. If any section of this Act or
14 any regulation issued under the authority of this Act should
15 be declared invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent
16 jurisdiction, the judicial determination shall not affect the
17 validity of the Act or regulations as a whole, or any part
18 thereof, other than the particular part declared invalid or
19 unenforceable.

20 Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect
21 upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
22 without such approval.
