AN ACT

To reappropriate fund balances from Public Law 9-1, Covenant Fund and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this bill is to reappropriate fund balances from Public Law 9-1, as appropriated for the construction of traffic lights at the Shell Dandan Gas Station intersection.

Section 2. Reappropriation. The fund balance of \$258,192.40 originally appropriated in Public Law 9-1 for the construction of traffic lights at the Dandan Shell Gas Station intersection is hereby reappropriated for the purpose of completing the paving of Afetna Road to Isabel Cabrera Road. The remaining balance will be used to pave all cross roads in Koblerville. Public Law 9-1 shall be deemed amended accordingly to conform to the provisions of this Act.

Section 3. Expenditure Authority. Expenditure authority shall rest with the Mayor of Saipan; funds shall be available without fiscal year limitation until fully expended. The expenditure authority is exempted from the CNMI Procurement regulations; provided, however, that at least three price quotations are solicited.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
