PUBLIC LAW NO. 11-120

AN ACT

To reappropriate fund balances from Public Law 9-1; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE ELEVENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS
COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:**

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this bill is reappropriate fund balances from Public Law 9-1 as appropriated for San Vicente Elementary School and San Antonio Elementary School for the construction of school libraries in both elementary school campuses.

Section 2. Reappropriation. There is hereby reappropriated from Section 4(c)(8) and (9) of Public Law 9-1 the unexpended fund balance of \$12,000.00 for the following projects:

- a) \$10,000.00 — for the repair and lighting of the San Vicente Basketball and Tennis courts; and
- b) \$2,000.00 — for the repair of the San Vicente Head Start School Facility.

Section 3. Expenditure Authority. Expenditure Authority shall rest with the Secretary of Public Works and funds shall be available without fiscal year limitation until fully expended.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any

liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
