

AN ACT

To re-appropriate fund balances from Public Law 7-36 and 9-1, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ELEVENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this bill is to re-appropriate fund balances from Public Law 7-36 as appropriated for the A & E design and construction of the Saipan Youth Center and Public Law 9-1 for Youth Center and Construction Management.

Section 2. Re-appropriation. There is hereby re-appropriated \$100,000 from the A&E design and construction of the Saipan Youth Center in Public Law 7-36, Section 104(4) and \$560,000 from Youth Center and Construction Management in Public Law 9-1, Section 3(c)(2) as follows:

1. For construction of two (2) Youth Center and collateral equipment in Precinct I.
 - a. \$310,000 for construction of Kagman Community and Youth Center.
 - b. \$110,000 for construction of Youth Center in Dandan.
2. \$100,000 for construction of one (1) Youth Center and collateral equipment in Precinct IV.
3. \$20,000 for Youth Center collateral equipment in Precinct III.
4. \$120,000 for the construction and renovation of Chalan Kanoa District #4 Community Center.

The Secretary of Public Works shall be the expenditure authority and the above funds shall remain available without fiscal year limitation.

Section 3 Severability. If any Section of this Act should be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
