

**AN ACT**

To re-appropriate fund balances from Public Law 7-36 and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE ELEVENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH  
LEGISLATURE:**

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this bill is to re-appropriate fund balances from Public Law 7-36 as appropriated for the A& E design and construction of the Saipan Youth Center.

Section 2. Re-appropriation. There is hereby re-appropriated \$250,000 from the A&E design and construction of the Saipan Youth Center for the purpose of constructing a Youth Center in Precinct III.

The Secretary of Public Works shall be the expenditure authority, funds shall be available without fiscal year limitation.

Section 3. Severability. If any Section of this Act should be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealer contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
