AN ACT

To amend Section 2(b)(1) of Public Law 11-7 to relocate the site to Tatachog, Rota and to transfer responsibility of the completed A&E and construction of a vocational shop and JROTC classrooms including storage rooms for the Rota High School to the Northern Marianas College for use by the college as their new campus; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE TWELFTH NORTHERN MARIANAS
COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:**

Section 1. Findings. The Legislature finds that the elected leaders of Rota favor Tatachog as the site for A&E and construction of a vocational shop and JROTC classrooms including storage rooms for the Rota high School. The Legislature further finds that the State Board of Education has affirmed their position that they will not accept responsibility of the JROTC/VOCED Buildings in a letter sent to the Mayor of Rota dated November 29, 1999.

Section 2. Amendments. Section 2(b)(1) of Public Law 11-7 is hereby amended to relocate the site to Tatachog, Rota and to transfer responsibility of the completed A&E and construction of a vocational shop and JROTC classrooms including storage rooms for the Rota High School to the Northern Marianas College for use by the College as their new campus.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers

contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
