AN ACT

TO REAPPROPRIATE THE AMOUNT OF \$31,458.00 FUND BALANCE FROM P. L. 9-1 SECTION 4(C)(1) AND FROM P. L. 10-15 FOR THE PURCHASE OF COLLATERAL EQUIPMENT FOR DANDAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS
COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:**

Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The legislature finds that the recently opened Dandan Elementary School in Precinct I is in dire need of collateral equipment necessary to satisfy the students' educational needs. The Legislature further finds that under the Precinct I Capital Improvement Projects pursuant to P. L. 9-1 section 4(c)(1), and P. L. 10-15 there is \$ 31,458.00 of unused funds which could be reappropriated for the above purposes.

Section 2. Re-appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law the Legislature hereby re-appropriates the unexpended and unobligated fund balance of \$2,458.00 from the Afetna road to Isabel Cabrera road, BU# 4948 and \$29,000.00 from the construction of the Dandan Youth Center Business Unit No. 4595 to the Dandan Elementary school collateral equipment.

Section 3. Expenditure Authority. The Principal, in consultation with the PTA Chairman and members of the Dandan school, shall be the expenditure authority of the sums appropriated under this act.

Section 4. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or its becoming law without such approval.
