PUBLIC LAW NO. 14-5
H. B. No. 14-137, SS1

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Six Dollars (\$374,766.00) for the relocation of the T-1 pump station to T-2 pump station at the Tanapag Social Hall; and \$316,600.00 to purchase earth-moving equipment and trucks for the Second Senatorial District; and up to \$316,600.00 for capital improvement projects for the First Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FOURTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Appropriation.

(a) There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$374,766.00, from the balance available for appropriation, inclusive of interest, earned under the 1987 \$140M Bond Issue administered by the Commonwealth Development Authority to fund the relocation of the T-1 pump station to the T-2 pump station at the Tanapag Social Hall.

(b) There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$316,600.00: ~~\$45,800.00 shall come from the Developers Infrastructure Tax Funds for the Second Senatorial District~~ and \$270,800.00 from the Solid Waste Management Fund for the Second Senatorial District. The funds appropriated under this subsection shall be used to purchase the following:

(1) For the Department of Public Works, Tinian:



Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or becoming law without such approval.


