PUBLIC LAW NO. 14-94  
**H. B. NO. 14-347**

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**AN ACT**

To appropriate the sum of \$30,000.00 from the Solid Waste Management Revolving Fund for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Public Law 13-42 to fund the expense of removing junk cars; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE FOURTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH  
LEGISLATURE:**

1           **Section 1. Purpose and Findings.** The Legislature finds that the accumulation of  
2 junk cars on residential and government premises in the Third Senatorial District is a  
3 problem. Motor oil and other motor fluid leakages from junk cars pose a hazardous threat to  
4 the environment. Junk cars also serve as nests for pests and are village eyesores. The intent  
5 of this Act is to provide funds to the Office of the Mayor of Saipan for the removal of junk  
6 cars which is defined under the term "scrap metal" in the Commonwealth Code from  
7 residential and government premises.

8           **Section 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated the amount of Thirty  
9 Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) from Public Law 13-42, Account-2082 (SWRF) for Saipan,  
10 to the Office of the Mayor of Saipan. The funds appropriated under this Act shall be used  
11 strictly to remove scrap metal as defined under 10 CMC § 3214 from residential and  
12 government premises for disposal at licensed scrap yards. In addition, funds appropriated  
13 under this Act shall not be reprogrammed.

14           **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** The expenditure authority of the funds  
15 appropriated under this Act shall be the Mayor of Saipan.


16           **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or the application of any such  
17 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent

1 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or  
2 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

3 **Section 5. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be  
4 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
5 repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers  
6 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law.  
7 The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying,  
8 any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act  
9 becomes effective.

10 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the  
11 Governor or becoming law without such approval.


