PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-45 SENATE BILL NO. 15-58, SS1, HD1

AN ACT

To waive the two-year prior nursing experience for non-resident workers who have completed the nursing education program at the Northern Marianas College so they can be hired as nurses in the Department of Public Health.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIFTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS **COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:**

Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The Legislature finds that there has always been and continues to be a shortage of locally hired nurses in the Department of Public Health. To augment the pool of local nurses the Northern Marianas College, in collaboration with the Department of Public Health, instituted a nursing education program. The legislature finds that a certain class of individuals who have completed the nursing education program are not permitted to work as nurses in the Commonwealth, unless they are hired as nonresident workers because of their alien status and, as such, are required under 3 CMC § 4434(b)(1) to have two years of work experience in the occupational field for which he or she is to be hired.

In contrast, local residents, other than non-resident workers, who have completed the same program, are eligible to be hired as nurses without necessarily having any prior experience working as a nurse. This is consistent with the government's effort to encourage more residents to choose nursing careers as they are in such great demand and yet in such short supply. The purpose of this act, therefore, is to waive the two-year prior nursing experience required of graduates of NMC's nursing education program who could not be immediately employed in the Department of Public Health due to their non-resident worker status. Without this act, the Department of Public Health would still need to hire nurses from off-island, a more expensive proposition due to recruitment, repatriation and other associated costs.

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Section 2. A new subsection (j) is added to 3 CMC §4434 to read:

"(j) Suspension of Statute. In the event that the Department of Public Health certifies that no local or other U.S. citizen applicants are available for nursing positions in the Commonwealth government, the two years experience requirement of 3 CMC § 4434(b)(1) shall not apply to a non-resident worker who completed the nursing education program at the Northern Marianas College, passed the NCLEX exam, and is subsequently employed, on or before December 31, 2009, in a nursing position with the CNMI Government.

This subsection (j) shall expire on January 1, 2010.

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Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. <u>Savings Clause</u>. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
