ANACT

TO PROVIDE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION WITH THE AUTHORITY TO REQUIRE MANAGEMENT AUDITS OF REGULATED ENTITIES.

The Bill was referred to the House Committee on Public Utilities, Transportation, and Communications, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-102, adopted on February 11, 2014.

with amendments in the form of H. B. 18-151, HS1 and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was referred to the Senate Committee on Public Utilities, Transportation, and Communications, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-59, adopted on May 2, 2014.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, MAY 2, 2014; without amendments and returned to THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON FEBRUARY 19, 2014.

H. B. 18-151, HS1

AN ACT

PROVIDE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION **AUTHORITY TO REQUIRE MANAGEMENT AUDITS OF REGULATED** ENTITIES.

Be it enacted by the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. Findings. Performance audits have been used with meaningful success in Guam and other jurisdictions to identify and eliminate unreasonable cost centers and to require regulated public utilities to implement "best practices" with substantial savings to the ratepayers. Performance audits are used as a regulatory tool throughout the United States.

Section 2. Amendment. 4 CMC § 8412 is amended by adding the following new subsection (f):

"(f) The Commonwealth Public Utilities Commission, shall consult with the Office of the Public Auditor, who shall conduct, and/or procure and oversee the services of performance auditing firms to conduct performance audits or other agreed upon procedures of each regulated entity and any of its operating divisions. Such audits would be performed from time to time as agreed upon by the Commission and the Public Auditor.

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HOUSE BILL 18-151, HS1

- (1) The purpose of these audits will be to produce findings and recommendations for action by the regulated entity to reduce unreasonable expenses and to improve the quality and efficiency of its management, operations, maintenance and service.
- (2) The regulated entity shall provide its full cooperation in the audit process, which shall be conducted at the expense of the regulated entity.
- (3) The Commission is empowered to issue such orders as it deems necessary to cause the regulated entity's findings and recommendations within a time frame established by the Commission. Audit reports and implementing regulatory orders shall be available for public review."

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

HOUSE BILL 18-151, HS1

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or its becoming law without such approval.
