H.B. 18-156, HD1

AN ACT

TO VEST THE COMMONWEALTH HEALTH CARE **CORPORATION (CHCC) WITH A CERTAIN PIECE OF PUBLIC** LAND: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The Bill was referred to the House Committee on Natural Resources, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-111; adopted May 6, 2014.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, JULY 8, 2014;

with amendments in the form of H. B. 18-156, HD1 and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was referred to the Senate Committee on Resources, Economic, Development and Programs. THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, AUGUST 5, 2014; without amendments and returned to THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON JULY 8, 2014.

AN ACT

TO VEST THE COMMONWEALTH HEALTH CARE CORPORATION (CHCC) WITH A CERTAIN PIECE OF PUBLIC LAND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. Short Title. This Act shall be cited as the "Medical Facilities Land Use Act of 2013".

Section 2. Findings. The Legislature finds as follows: Lots 098 D 04 and 098 D 05, parcels of public land situated at the northeast corner of Chalan Pale Arnold and Navy Hill Road, and consisting of a total of approximately 38,574 square meters, are currently vacant and unused. Over the years, various proposals have been advanced by various persons for the use of the said lots, including a shopping mall, a courthouse, and others. However, because of the lots' position directly adjacent to the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation (CHCC); because CHCC has already expanded to the full capacity of the property lion which it is situated; because no other site is as well situated as the said lots for the construction of additional medical facilities; and because of the critical importance of safeguarding and maintaining the public health as effectively and efficiently as possible, it is in the best interest of the people of the Commonwealth that the lots be used for medical facilities.

Section 3. Land designation and management. The management, control, and disposition of a certain public land, specifically Lot Nos. 098 D 04 and 098 D 05 located at the northeast corner of Chalan Pale Arnold and Navy Hill Road on the island of Saipan shall be transferred from the Department of Public Lands to the Commonwealth Health Care Corporation (CHCC). The said Lot Nos. are hereby dedicated exclusively for medical facilities directly associated with the medical facilities of CHCC. Furthermore, the design and construction on the said lots shall be limited to the construction of medical facilities and include a small park or rest area for patients and staff. "Medical facilities" means physical structures in which activities directly related to health care and health support are carried out, including but not limited to hospitals, hospices, pharmacies, nursing homes, clinics, medical laboratories, Veterans Affairs Outreach Clinic, and assisted living facilities. "Medical facilities" does not include facilities primarily dedicated to commercial or governmental activities not directly related to health care; even if such activities may generate proceeds that indirectly benefit health care. Construction on the said lots other than the construction of medical facilities is prohibited. Conveyance of the said lots or of any portion of or interest in the said lots, for any purpose other than the construction, maintenance or operation of medical facilities is prohibited.

Section 4. <u>Severability.</u> If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

HOUSE BILL 18-156, HD1

Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or its becoming law without such approval.
