Representative Antonio P. Sablan, of Saipan, Precinct 1 (*for himself*, Representative Mariano Taitano,) in an open and public meeting with an opportunity for the public to comment, introduced the following Bill:

H. B. No. 18-57, HD1

AN ACT

TO AMEND 4 CMC §5611(B) (BUSINESS LICENSE FEES); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The Bill was referred to the House Committee on Commerce, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-54; adopted October 10, 2013.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, OCTOBER 10, 2013; with amendments in the form of H. B. 18-57, HD1 and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was referred to the Senate Committee on Fiscal Affairs. THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, OCTOBER 16, 2014; without amendments and returned to THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON OCTOBER 10, 2013.

AN ACT

TO AMEND 4 CMC § 5611 (B) (BUSINESS LICENSE FEES); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. <u>Findings and purpose</u>. The Commonwealth Legislature finds that many businesses in the Commonwealth are opening shops in different locations within the Commonwealth, while only paying for one business license for multiple locations. The Legislature further finds that the Commonwealth can collect additional resources by charging businesses for all locations in which the same line of businesses is being offered. Additionally, the Legislature finds that many businesses are taking advantage of this incentive and over the years have made maximum profits with this loophole in the Commonwealth's current statutes. Therefore, the intent of this Act is to require a business license for each business location regardless of the line of business.
