TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 12-64 SECTION 7(B) SPECIAL APPROPRIATION: EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.

The Bill was not referred to a House Committee.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, FEBRUARY 19, 2016; without amendments and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was not referred to a Senate Committee. THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, MARCH 11, 2016; without amendments and was returned to THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON FEBRUARY 19, 2016.

H. B. No. 19-135

AN ACT

TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 12-64 SECTION 7(B) SPECIAL APPROPRIATION: EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Nineteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. <u>Findings</u>. The Legislature finds a need to amend the Expenditure Authority provision of Public Law 12-64 to take into consideration the most effective way of expending the funds for Capital Improvement Projects once awarded. The legislature further finds that the most effective and efficient way to expend such funds, most especially for the First and Second Senatorial Districts, is to empower the Mayors of each respective Senatorial District with the authority.

Section 2. <u>Amendment</u>. Section 7(b) of Public Law 12-64 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. Special Appropriation: Expenditure Authority.

(b) Expenditure authority over funds appropriated pursuant to this section shall be:

(1) The Secretary of Public Works for the Third Senatorial District.

(2) The Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan for the Second Senatorial District.

(3) The Mayor of Rota for the First Senatorial District."

Section 3. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, 15 any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

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HOUSE BILL 19-135
