14 **THIS MATTER** came before the court on June 22, 2006 at 1:30
15 p.m. for a Review Hearing in Courtroom 223A. The government was
16 represented by Assistant Attorney General John Aguon. The
17 defendant appeared *Pro Se*.

21 ***95-07889.***

22 The court closed this case along with the admonition to
23 Defendant in court that his substantial non-compliance with the
24 terms and conditions of his probation makes him an extremely
25 poor candidate for probation and that this fact be considered if

1 and when he appears in court again. Although the government did
2 move to revoke his probation during the probationary period, for
3 some reason it did not go forward. The time has passed to pursue
4 any further process in this matter and the court must now close
5 this Defendant's several traffic cases with a write off of the
6 substantial fines and obligations owed to the government.
