

CNMI BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW AND AMENDED REGULATIONS

The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Board of Education, hereby notifies the general public of its intention to propose new regulations previously called policies for the governance of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Public School System. The proposed regulations previously called policies are promulgated pursuant to the authority provided by Article XV of the CNMI Constitution, Public Law 6-10 and the Administrative Procedures Act.

POLICY 604.5(e)(2)&(3) STUDENT ABSENCES AND EXCUSES

604.5(e)(2) is amended, 604.5(e)(3) is created, and the rest of 604 remains the same.

604.5

(e) 2) Secondary school students (grades 7-12) who incur 13 or more absences in a course during the first or second semester cannot receive a passing grade for that course for that semester. For the purposes of this policy, three unexcused tardies within a semester from a course shall equal one unexcused absence from the course for that semester.

Students who are not able to receive a passing grade for a semester due to an accumulation of 13 or more absences as defined in this policy shall receive a "non credit" (NC) on their academic record. This NC shall be deleted if the student receives a passing grade in the course during any semester after the one in which the NC was received.

3) After the sixth absence in any course during the semester, a doctor's excuse will be required for any further absences to be considered excused, unless a waiver for that absence is obtained from the school principal.

POLICY 606: USE OF STUDENT RECORDS

The Title of Policy 606 is amended to Read The Use of Student Records. The substance of Policy 606 is amended to read in its entirety:

606.1 Permanent Records

A permanent record shall be established for each student entering the Public School System. The principal of the school in which the entering student enrolls shall be responsible for establishing the permanent student record. The permanent records shall include the following information:

- (a) The name and sex of the student as given in a legal document, such as a birth certificate, court order, or official record of schools previously attended.
- (b) Any other name(s) by which the student may be identified.
- (c) The student's date of birth, and the method of verification of the date of birth for a student being admitted to the first grade.

- (d) The name and address of the student's parent or parents, or other person or persons having custody of the student if the student is a minor.
- (e) The student's primary language and ethnic background.
- (f) A record of the entering and leaving dates for all school sessions previously attended by the student.
- (g) A record of the instruction in which the student participated, and of the student's rating or achievement in instruction (student progress report or equivalent).
- (h) Test score records.
- (i) Any Specific Health Problem and verification of immunization.
- (j) Social Security Number, Hospital Number and Blood Type.
- (k) Insurance Company
- (l) disciplinary records related to all suspensions and expulsions
- (m) other pertinent educational information, including attendance.

606.2 Use of Student Records

School administrators, counselors, and teachers shall, with the approval of the Principal, have access to permanent records of students at the school, provided that the person seeking access has a demonstrated educational interest in matters within the records.

Student records shall be made available for inspection by the student, or by the parent or legal guardian of the student if the student is a minor, upon request and subject to the requirements of Section 603, during normal working hours.

Upon the written request of a parent or other person having custody of a minor student, or upon the written request of a student over the age of minority, copies of the student's permanent records may be released to other persons, agencies, or institutions with demonstrated interest in the student.

A student's permanent record shall be forwarded to another school upon request of the principal of that school, and upon notice of enrollment of the student in that school. A copy of the complete file shall be retained by the forwarding school.

Pursuant to 1 CMC Sec. 2378 the Division of Youth Services shall have access to student records with or without the consent or authorization of the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) if that student is a minor, or the consent of the student if that student is eighteen (18) years of age or older.

Provided however, that requesting agency shall, in writing:

- (a) demonstrate its interest in the student record
- (b) specify the particular record or information requested
- (c) list the name or names of agency personnel authorized to have access to information being sought.

Additionally, no copies of student records shall be made, nor student records leave the school administration office. Principal or his/her designee of the school where access to student records is being requested shall provide a space or room for authorized agency personnel requesting access to review records.

Pursuant to Section 1532 (b) of P.L. No. 6-10 access to student records requested by the parents, legal guardians, or students shall be granted within 5 days of the date of request. The requester shall be notified of the location of all centrally located student records. If necessary qualified personnel to interpret records will be made available.

POLICY 609.3 TITLE CHANGE ONLY STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The Title of Policy 609.3 is amended from "STUDENT EXPULSION POLICY" to read "STUDENT SUSPENSION FOR MORE THAN TEN DAYS." The substance of the policy remains the same.

POLICY 614 FULL AND PART-TIME STUDENTS

Policy 614 is amended to read in it entirety:

Students shall be considered full time when enrolled the entire instructional day. A student enrolled less than the entire instructional day shall be considered a part-time student.

While the part-time students are on campus, all applicable policies will apply as if they were in school full-time.

POLICY 616 STUDENTS BEYOND NORMAL AGE OF ATTENDANCE

Policy 616 is amended to add subsections (4)(5)&(6). Subsections (1)(2)&(3) remain the same.

- A student over the compulsory attendance age may not register for school after the second week of the first quarter of the school year unless he/she is a transferee from another school and has been in attendance during that school year. These restrictions shall not apply to special education students or students who have an excusable reason for late registration, such as illness.
- A student over the compulsory attendance age who has accumulated a total of twenty-five (25) days and/or five consecutive days of unexcused absences shall be dropped from school for the balance of that academic year. If the student is a special education student the school principal has the discretion to grant a waiver.
- High school students shall be given six continuous calendar years to complete their graduation requirements, commencing from their first day in the 9th grade. Students who do not complete their graduation requirements by the end of this period may be denied entrance to school in subsequent years. Permission to return to school may therefore be denied to dropout students if they would be unable to complete their graduation requirements by the end of the six year period.

POLICY 623 PERMISSION TO LEAVE SCHOOL GROUNDS

Policy 308 is rescinded in its entirety and replaced by Policy 623 which is created to read in its entirety:

Students may not leave school grounds from the time of their arrival until the time they leave at the end of the day unless they have written permission from a parent or legal guardian, a signed liability waiver form suitable to the Commissioner, and the permission of the principal or their written designee to do so.

"Parent or legal guardian" shall mean the person designated as such in the student's school registration materials.

POLICY 624 VISITORS TO THE SCHOOLS

Policy 624 is created to read in its entirety:

624.1 Type of Visitors Covered:

These rules apply to all persons who may come to the school for any reason during the school day.

Visitors who are transporting employees or students to and from school are not covered by these rules if they are strictly involved in the loading or unloading of said passengers or if they are waiting for their passengers within a reasonable time at the designated parking or loading area.

624.2 Procedures:


All visitors must report to the school office and obtain permission to be on the school grounds, employees of the school system are to sign in and to advise the school principal or representative that they are on campus.

624.3 Supervision of Visitors:

Any person on school property whose presence has not been authorized by the school office is illegally on campus. Unauthorized school visitors shall be requested by any school employee to obtain visitor authorization through the principal office or to leave the school grounds. If the visitor refuses to comply with this request or creates any disturbance, the incident shall be reported immediately to the principal or his designee, who has the authority to request assistance from the police.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Citation of Statutory Authority:

1 CMC §2605 states that "the Department of Public Health ... shall adopt rules and regulations regarding those matters over which it has jurisdiction, including but not limited to regulations deemed necessary to the public health and safety respecting: (j) Hospitals, clinics ..." 1 CMC §2603(f) grants the Department of Public Health the power and duty to administer all government-owned health care facilities.

Short Statement of Goals & Objectives:

The Department of Public Health must revise its fee schedule from time to time in order to reflect the actual cost of providing health services, or to add fees for services that become available as a result of new equipment acquisitions or the addition of medical personnel in a particular specialty area.

Brief Summary of the Proposed Rule:

To establish fees for services provided at the various health care facilities operated by the Department of Public Health, including the Commonwealth Health Center, the Tinian Health Center, the Rota Health Center, the Division of Public Health, and the San Antonio Clinic.

PUBLIC NOTICE

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Title 1 CMC Division 2, Chapter 12, and in particular 1 CMC \$2603(f) and 2605(j), provides that the Secretary of the Department of Public Health (DPH) shall administer all government owned facilities and shall implement rules and regulations for the efficient delivery of health services in the CNMI.

Pursuant to this authority, the Secretary is amending specific fees from the Schedule of Medical and Other Related Fees which was published in its entirety, and adopted, in the Commonwealth Register Volume 17, Number 2, dated February 15, 1995 and Volume 17, Number 4, dated April 15, 1995, respectively. These amendments are necessary to reflect accurately in the Schedule of Medical and Other Related Fees the types of services that are now being provided by the Department. The amendments are attached herewith and will be incorporated into the DPH Schedule of Medical and Other Related Fees upon adoption.

In adopting these Amendments to the Schedule of Fees, it is the intention of the Department of Public Health to comply with the requirements of the Administrative Procedure Act, specifically 1 CMC §9104. Copies of the proposed Amendments to the Schedule of Fees may be obtained from the Office of the Secretary of Public Health located at the ground floor of CHC. Comments on the proposed Amendments to the Schedule of Fees may be sent to the Office of the Secretary of Public Health, P.O. Box 409 CK, Saipan, MP 96950. 
