HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 18-53, D1

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$33,100.00 from local license fees collected from poker and pachinko slot machines in the First Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

\$33,100.00 from local license fees for poker and pachinko slot machines collected pursuant to 10 CMC §1901 to activities for the First Senatorial District. The Commonwealth Legislature enacts this legislation under its authority in Article II, sections 1 and 6 of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands. The First Senatorial District Delegation finds that there is a need to provide a subsistence allowance for residents of the First Senatorial District who are undergoing dialysis and treatment for terminal illnesses outside of the First Senatorial District.

Section 2. Appropriations. The amount of \$33,100.00 is appropriated from local license fees for poker and pachinko slot machines collected pursuant to 10 CMC §1901 for the following purposes:

a) \$26,400.000 to the Department of Finance for the purpose of providing a monthly subsistence allowance for residents of the First Senatorial District who are undergoing dialysis treatment and treatment for terminal illnesses outside of the First Senatorial District. The monthly subsistence allowance shall not exceed \$450.00 per month.

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- b) \$2,500.00 to the Rota Municipal Scholarship Fund pursuant to Rota Local Law 17-02.
- e) \$1,200.00 to reimburse a prior appropriation shortfall for the hemodialysis and terminally-ill patients' subsistence allowance.
- d) \$3,000,00 to cover some of the expenses related to the celebration of the Mes Man Amko' such as air fare, hotel/motel lodging, and van rental for ground transportation.

Section 3. Expenditure Authority.

- a) The expenditure authority for subsections (a) and (c) of Section 2 shall be the Secretary of Finance; and subsection (b) shall be the Chairperson of the Rota Municipal Scholarship Program.
- b) The expenditure authority for subsection (d) of Section 2 shall be the Rota Aging Program Director, Mrs. Josepha B. Manglona.

Section 4. Reprogramming. Notwithstanding any provisions, laws to the contrary, funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purposes.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule. regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

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Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
