
Dear Governor Inos:



**HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 18-57, S1**

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate \$31,900.00 from local license fees collected for poker and pachinko slot machines in the First Senatorial District and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1  
OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1           **Section 1. Purpose.** The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the amount of  
2           \$31,900.00 from local license fees for poker and pachinko slot machines collected pursuant to  
3           10 CMC §1901 to activities for the First Senatorial District. The Commonwealth Legislature  
4           enacts this legislation under its authority in Article II, sections 1 and 6 of the Constitution of  
5           the Northern Mariana Islands. The First Senatorial District Delegation finds that there is a  
6           need to provide a subsistence allowance for residents of the First Senatorial District who are  
7           undergoing dialysis and treatment for terminal illnesses outside of the First Senatorial District.

8           **Section 2. Appropriations.** The amount of \$31,900.00 is appropriated from local  
9           license fees for poker and pachinko slot machines collected pursuant to 10 CMC §1901 for the  
10          following purposes:

- 11           a)    \$26,400.00 to the Department of Finance for the purpose of providing a monthly  
12           subsistence allowance for residents of the First Senatorial District who are  
13           undergoing dialysis treatment and treatment for terminal illnesses outside of the  
14           First Senatorial District. [See Attachment "A"] The monthly subsistence  
15           allowance shall not exceed \$450.00 per month.

1           b) \$3,190.00 for the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation pursuant to Rota Local  
2           Law 17-02.

3           c) \$2,310.00 as partial payment to Alamo Car Rental for the outstanding account  
4           owed by the Office of the Mayor of Rota.

5           **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** The expenditure authority for subsection (a)  
6           shall be the Secretary of Finance. The expenditure authority for subsection (b) shall be the  
7           Chairperson of the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation. The expenditure authority for  
8           subsection (c) shall be the Mayor of Rota.

9           **Section 4. Reprogramming.** Notwithstanding any provisions, laws to the contrary,  
10          funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purposes.

11          **Section 5. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or the application of any such  
12          provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent  
13          jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or  
14          circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


15          **Section 6. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be  
16          construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
17          repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained  
18          in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The  
19          enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any  
20          liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes  
21          effective.

1           **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the  
2 Governor or its becoming law without such approval.


