## ROTA LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT EIGHTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE

FOURTH SPECIAL SESSION, 2014

**HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 18-58, D1** 

### A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate the Two Million US Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) allotted to the First Senatorial District under Public Law No. 18-56; and for other purposes

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

- **Section 1.** <u>Appropriation.</u> Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the contrary, the amount of Two Million US Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) allotted to the First Senatorial District under Public Law No. 18-56 is hereby appropriated as follows:
  - (a) \$1,619,706.87 for the payment of the twenty five percent (25%) retirement cut restoration for the retirees and surviving beneficiaries of the First Senatorial District residing on Rota and outside of Rota under the expenditure authority of the Secretary of the Department of Finance which shall be distributed as follows:
    - (1) Each retiree or surviving beneficiary to receive a lump sum payment of the 25% pension cut from October 15, 2013 to August 15, 2014.

Thereafter, commencing on August 30, 2014 and ending on September 30, 2014, each retiree or survivor shall receive a payment of the 25% pension cut on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of each month concurrently with their retirement checks from the Settlement Fund.

- (b) \$50,000 for the payment of the debt owed to the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) as appropriated in Saipan Local Law No. 16-4 under the expenditure authority of the Chairman of SNILD.
- (c) \$330,293.13 shall be reserved for prospective payments of the 25% retirement cut restoration for the retirees and surviving beneficiaries of the First Senatorial District and shall be deposited into a special account, separate from the general account of the First Senatorial District, to be appropriated at a later time for disbursement.
- **Section 2.** Fund Distribution. Funds appropriated under this Act shall be distributed accordingly to the intended entities upon this Act becoming law.
- Section 3. Reporting and Reprogramming. Each expenditure authority shall submit to the Chairperson of the Rota Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of the funds at the completion of appropriations in section 1 of this Act. Furthermore, funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.
- **Section 4.** <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

**Section 6.** Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
