Representative Teresita A. Santos, of Rota, Precinct 7 (for herself,) in an open and public meeting with an opportunity for the public to comment, introduced the following Bill:

H. B. No. 18-106, HD1

AN ACT

TO AMEND 2 CMC§5631, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW 17-13, TO AUTHORIZE ONE-HALF INCH NET MESH TO CATCH BIGEYE SCAD (ATULAI) AND TO ALLOW NET FISHING FOR GOAT FISH (TIAO) DURING THEIR SEASONAL RUN IN THE FIBST SENATORIAL DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The Bill was referred to the House Committee on Natural Resources, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-52, adopted on September 26, 2013.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, OCTOBER 25, 2013; with amendments in the form of H. B. 18-106, HD1 and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was referred to the Senate Committee on Resources, Economic, Development and Programs. THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, NOVEMBER 26, 2013; without amendments and returned to the HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON OCTOBER 25, 2013.

AN ACT

TO AMEND 2 CMC §5631, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW 17-13, TO AUTHORIZE ONE-HALF INCH NET MESH TO CATCH BIGEYE SCAD (ATULAI) AND TO ALLOW NET FISHING FOR GOAT FISH (TIAO) DURING THEIR SEASONAL RUN IN THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTBICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. <u>Findings and Purpose</u>. The Legislature finds that non-commercial netfishing has been a traditional source of food for the people of the CNMI. Fishing has traditionally been relied upon to support and sustain families. The Legislature is cognizant that certain nets with net mesh not smaller than two inches are authorized in the waters surrounding the First Senatorial District. The intent of this Act is to authorize certain nets with net mesh of not less than one-half inch to catch Bigeye Scad (Atulai) and to allow nets to catch goat fish (Tiao) during their respective seasonal run.

Section 2. Amendment. Subject to codification by the Law Revision Commission,

"(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) and (c), it shall be unlawful for any commercial and non-commercial fishermen to use explosives, poisons, electric shocking devices, scuba tank or hookah when fishing for reef fish and harvesting other marine life within waters of the Commonwealth, provided however, that the use of throw nets (talaya), or the use of the following types of nets provided the net mesh size are no smaller than two inches, drag nets (chenchulun lagua), surround nets (chenchulun umesugon) or trap nets (chenchulun managam) shall be legal in the waters surrounding the First Senatorial District when used for non-commercial purposes only. Non-commercial purpose means fish caught for personal or immediate family use. Any sales or distribution beyond ones immediate family shall be a violation of this law.

(b) The use of the following types of nets, drag nets (chenchulun lagua). surround nets (chenchulun umesugon) or trap nets (chenchulun managam) shall be legal in the waters surrounding the First Senatorial District when used for noncommercial purposes to catch Bigeye Scad (Atulai) during its seasonal run provided the net mesh size is not less than one-half inch. The fee for the mesh net under this subsection shall be \$25.00 for every 50-feet net in length for each Atulai seasonal run.

(c) The use of the following types of nets drag nets (chenchulun lagua), surround nets (chenchulun umesugon) or trap nets (chenchulun managam) shall be legal in the waters surrounding the First Senatorial District when used for noncommercial purposes to catch Juvenile Goat Fish (Tiao) during its seasonal run

provided the net mesh size is not less than one-half inch. The fee for the mesh net under this subsection shall be \$25.00 for every 50-feet net in length for each Tiao seasonal run."

Section 3. <u>Rules and Regulations</u>. The Rota Resident Director of the Department of Lands and Natural Resources shall promulgate rules and regulations designating the period of the seasonal run for Atulai and Tiao and other necessary rules and regulations consistent with this Act.

8 Section 4. <u>Severability.</u> If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such 9 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent 10 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or 11 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. <u>Savings Clause</u>. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
