# H. B. No. 18-144, HS1

AN ACT

### TO AMEND 1 CMC SECTION 20161 (C) AS ENACTED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-43 BY REDUCING THE COMMONWEALTH PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS FROM TEN (10) MEMBERS DOWN TO SIX (6) MEMBERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The Bill was referred to the House Committee on Public Utilities, Transportation, and Communications, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-84, adopted on January 9, 2014.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, FEBRUARY 19,2014; with amendments in the form of H. B. 18-144, HS1 and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was referred to the Senate Committee on Public Utilities, Transportation, and Communications, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-57, adopted on May 2, 2014. THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, MAY 2, 2014; without amendments and returned to THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON FEBRUARY 19, 2014.

## H. B. 18-144, HS1

#### **AN ACT**

#### TÛ AMEND CMC SECTION AS ENACTED 1 20161 (C) BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-43 BY REDUCING THE COMMONWEALTH PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS FROM TEN (10)IEMBERS DOWN TO SIX (6) MEMBERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

#### Be it enacted by the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The Legislature created the Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority (COTA) to administer federal grants from the Federal Transit Administration. COTA's primary duties are to assess the transportation needs of the Commonwealth and to develop a public transportation system.

Under the current law, COTA has a total of eleven (11) Commonwealth Public Transportation Advisory Board members. The Legislature finds that COTA board members should be reduced to allow for a more streamlined and efficient discussion and decision making. The Legislature further finds that the reduction in the number of board members enables a more focused strategic planning while still representing the community.

#### Section 2. Amendments.

1 CMC Section 20161 (c) as is amended to read as follows:

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#### HOUSE BILL 18-144, HS1

#### § 20161 Establishment of the Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority.

"(c) In the Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority, there shall be a Commonwealth Public Transportation Advisory Board to be chaired by the board member voted on by a majority vote of the members of the board and shall be comprised of the Special Assistant for Public Transportation, Secretary of the Department of Public Works, a representative from the Public School System, a representative of the Mayor of the First and Second Senatorial District and a representative from the business community.

(1) The Commonwealth Public Transportation Advisory Board consisting of six voting members and shall have at least one (1) female member and one (1) member who is of Carolinian descent."

Section 3. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

16 Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes 18 repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

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Public Law No. 18-51 HOUSE BILL 18-144, HS1 Section 5. Effective Date.
