H. B. No. 18-39, HD1

AN ACT

TO AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSMENT OF PARKING METER FEES, TO REQUIRE SEGREGATION OF FEES COLLECTED BY SENATORIAL DISTRICT, AND TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL APPROPRIATION OF THOSE FEES.

The Bill was referred to the House Committee on Ways and Means, which submitted Standing Committee Report 18-60; adopted October 24, 2013.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, OCTOBER 25, 2013;

with amendments in the form of H. B. 18-39, HD1 and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was referred to the Senate Committee on Fiscal Affairs.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, MAY 28, 2014;

without amendments and returned to

THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON OCTOBER 25, 2013.

AN ACT

TO AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSMENT OF PARKING METER FEES, TO REQUIRE SEGREGATION OF FEES COLLECTED BY SENATORIAL DISTRICT, AND TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL APPROPRIATION OF THOSE FEES.

Be it enacted by the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. Findings. This Act may be cited as the "Parking Meter Act."

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that Department of Public Works and the Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority (COTA) have statutory authority to assess fees associated with parking be deposited according to which senatorial district generated the fees and into separate accounts designated for each senatorial district. The fees collected would be subject to appropriation by the respective legislative delegations. This Act also gives COTA the authority to create regulations so that COTA may effectively use and administer the fees in furtherance of an operational transit system.

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HOUSE BILL 18-39, HD1

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Section 3. Amendments.

(a) 1 CMC § 2403 (b) is amended as follows:

"(b) To construct, maintain, and operate public signs, traffic signals, parking meters, public vessels, public buildings, and public works functions previously performed by chartered municipalities, unless otherwise provided by law."

(b) 1 CMC § 2404 is amended as follows:

"§ 2404. Department of Public Works: Rules and Regulations. The Department of Public Works shall adopt rules and regulations regarding those matters over which the department has jurisdiction including establishing reasonable fees for functions authorized under 1 CMC § 2403 (b).

(c) Title 1, Division 2, Chapter 8 of the Commonwealth is amended by adding a new § 2406 as follows:

"§ 2406. All fees collected from parking meters constructed, maintained and operated by Department of Public Works pursuant to 1 CMC §§ 2403(b) and 2404 shall be deposited into an account designated by the Department of Finance for the district where the fees are derived and subject to local appropriation under 1 CMC section 1402 (c), provided however, that 50% of the funds (fees and fines) collected from each Senatorial District shall be deposited into an account for the Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority (COTA) for which the Special Assistant for Public Transportation shall be the expenditure authority."

- (d) Title 9, division 5, Chapter 8 Section 5812 is hereby amended as follows:
- (1) by adding the words "Parking Meters" at the end of the title of the section;
- (2) designating the current provisions as a new subsection (a) and redesignating existing subsections (a) thru (e) as paragraph (1) thru (5), and adding a new subsection (b) to read as follows:

"(b) Parking meters. In consultation with the Secretary of Public Works, the Commissioner of Public Safety designate areas along the public roadways appropriate for the installation and operation of parking meters. The Department of Public Safety shall be responsible for enforcing the time limits imposed by parking meters installed pursuant to 1 CMC § 2406, including but not limited to issuing citations, and shall have the authority to issue reasonably necessary regulations including fines of not more than \$100 to enforce the time limits indicated by the parking meters."

- (e) 1 CMC § 1402(c) is amended by adding a new paragraph (6) as follows:
- "(6) Fees collected from parking meters constructed, maintained and operated by Department of Public Works pursuant to 1 CMC §§ 2403 (b) and 2404; provided the fees shall be used for enforcement relating to parking meter administration."

Section 4. <u>Severability.</u> If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 6. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or its becoming law without such approval.
